Fanny's parents and the family were very active church members. The sisters were actively associated with the Sunday School <sup>5</sup>.

Fannys' parents settled in Warrnambool some time prior to 1858. They were self sufficient with a cow<sup>1</sup>, Elizabeth sold milk to the hospital<sup>2</sup>, they had a well kept vegetable garden<sup>3</sup>. Samuel set up his own Bacon Curing business<sup>4</sup>.

Fanny attended school at the Methodist School room in Koroit Street Warrnambool.

When Fanny and William first married they settled with her in-laws, at "Spring Gardens" before moving to the West Reserve and finally to 32 Princess Street. Following the death of her husband William in 1927, her son and daughter in law, Aubrey and Edythe, moved in with her.

Some-time between 1931 and 1934 she moved to Randwick East, Watson, New South Wales, to live with her daughter and son in law, Nellie and Harold Blackler.

Fanny signed the 1891 Women's Suffrage Petition. She was residing in Lava Street Warrnambool at the time. (Her name appears on Page 3, line 2.)
