


Hello members,

On Friday 14 July a morning tea and exhibition was held at the Lighthouse Theatre to commemorate the centenary of the establishment of infant welfare services in Victoria. Although the first Baby Health Centre opened in Richmond in 1917, the instigator of the service was Warrnambool's Dr Isabella Younger Ross. W&DHS lent items from our collection for the exhibition, which was organized by the Warrnambool City Council's Child Services department. Our set of baby scales, the memorial stone from Warrnambool's first baby health centre, 1927, and a copy of the book *The Happy Mother and Child* by Dr Younger Ross were among several items which made a really interesting display tracing the early development of this vital service, which today we take for granted. Prior to the establishment of health centres high infant mortality rates were a fact of life.
